POLICY

1. Non-playing directors will receive \$25.00 for regular games, \$30.00 for special games - special games being those games with computerized hands, and an additional \$5.00 if there is an Intermediate/Novice game along with the open game. Playing directors will receive \$25.00 plus free play per game and an additional \$5.00 if there is an Intermediate/Novice game along with the open game. Directors or their agents will be paid a fee of \$10.00 to prepare boards from computer printouts for computer dealt games, if necessary.
When the director is required to play in an emergency, or to accommodate out-of-town guests, there will be no change in the director's payment, nor will there be any game fee charged to the director for playing.
2. Game directors should use movements listed in the standard schedule:
 - Regular Games: Movements consisting of 24 to 28 boards, minimizing factoring.
 - Novice Games: Standard movements to be used consisting of approximately 20 boards.
 - Special Games: One winner movements (Howell or Scrambled Mitchell). Director to have option of using regular movement when a large number of tables is present, providing the field is seeded fairly.
3. Club games will be stratified as follows: C strata, 0 - 200 masterpoints, B strata, 201-500 mps and A strata, over 500 mps. Special games will be stratified as per instructions.
4. Game director may change, when necessary, positioning of pairs to ensure a more balanced field. Players shall not deliberately, week after week, attempt to seat themselves in a particular direction, except in cases of infirmity.
5. All allowable special games will be scheduled. Scheduling of Unit or Nationwide Games not falling on regular night will be optional.
6. Conventions in class A, B and C are permitted to be used. Other conventions may be allowed, providing approval of the game director is obtained prior to the start of the game (see posted lists). Both the "Alert" and the "Skip Bid" procedures will be followed. A maximum of two Psychs (uncontrolled) will be permitted during any session, by any partnership. All psychs should be reported discreetly to the game director. Excessive use of psychs will be penalized at the discretion of the director. The minimum penalty will be average minus.
7. Official starting time will be 7:00 p.m. All players should be seated at the proper table, ready to play by that time. Players coming late will be warned. On the third offense, players will be permitted to play in that game only at the convenience of the director and other players.
8. Rounds will be called every 15 minutes for two boards and every 20 minutes for three boards. Late plays will be given if a board has not been started when the round is called. Two late plays may result in a penalty of half a board, unless, in the opinion of the director, the delay is caused by the slow play of other pairs.
9. In memoriam donations: A \$50.00 donation and sympathy card will be made by the secretary on behalf of the Brockville Duplicate Bridge Club for the following: Brockville Duplicate Bridge Club member; spouse of Brockville Duplicate Bridge Club member; children of Brockville Duplicate Bridge Club member; parent of Brockville Duplicate Bridge Club member. Sympathy cards will be circulated and sent for other family members of the Brockville Duplicate Bridge Club.
